



PPWR Declaration - Regulation (EU) 2025/40 Packaging Compliance for Rubber Products

Declaration

We hereby declare that the packaging used for the shipment of rubber products and associated materials has been developed in line with the requirements and principles set out in Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste (PPWR).

Our packaging solutions are designed to:

- reduce the overall quantity of packaging materials required
- ensure that the packaging materials used can be recycled
- encourage the use of reusable packaging solutions for transportation
- contribute to circular economy practices throughout the supply chain

Pallets are used as reusable packaging wherever possible and are included in established return and reuse systems.

Packaging Design Principles

The packaging systems used for Rubber deliveries are designed to:

- protect Rubber products during transport and storage
- enable multiple reuse cycles for pallets, protection cover and corner protection
- ensure material separation and recycling
- avoid unnecessary packaging materials



This declaration certifies conformity with the mentioned directives but is not to be considered as a guarantee of concessions in case of improper use. The product documentation's safety instructions are to be adhered to.

Based on the information available to us, the packaging materials used for deliveries are **recyclable and designed in line with the requirements and objectives of Regulation (EU) 2025/40**.

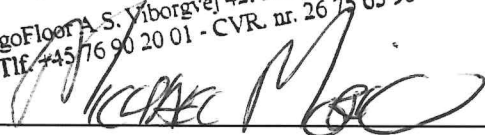
Our company continuously monitors regulatory developments and will ensure full compliance with the PPWR requirements once the regulation becomes fully applicable.
